

## Call for Nomination

### **Framework Contract for Supply of I&C Mechanical Components (Lot 6)**

#### **1 Purpose**

This Call for Nomination is for the selection of companies to bid for supply of the I&C Mechanical Components.

#### **2 Background**

ITER is a joint international research and development project that aims to demonstrate the scientific and technical feasibility of fusion power. For the construction of its experimental reactor, the IO needs to purchase construction components, and this Call for Nomination is to procure the I&C Mechanical Components.

#### **3 Scope**

IO will put in place a framework contract with the selected supplier in order to procure I&C Mechanical Components.

The Supply will normally consist of items listed in the table below:

2-Valve Manifold	SS304L or SS316L	1/2"
5-Valve Manifold	SS304L or SS316L	1/2"
Pressure Snubber	SS304L or SS316L	1/2" OD
Male Connector for Sensor and Cap	SS304L or SS316L	1/2" x 1/2" OD
Inst. Needle Valve	SS304L or SS316L	1/2"
Tube Cap	SS304L or SS316L	1/2" OD
Level Pot Condensing	SS304L or SS316L	1 litre
Sensor Mounting Box	not specified (*)	approx. 650x300x200 mm

(\*) For the mounting box, material such as Stainless Steel, Carbon Steel with coating, Aluminium with coating can be used.

The purpose of the mounting box is to provide a physical protection shielding for the sensor and the associated manifold (for scaffolding or equipment installation/removal) as well as to minimize operator time in the room for maintenance activity (sensor and manifold are fitting on a mounting plate which can be clamped to the box on site).

All components shall be designed for the seismic events with Zero Period Acceleration up to 6.5 g.

The selected supplier will be in charge of:

- a) Manufacturing
- b) Packing and delivery of the required goods to the ITER Organization
- c) Submission of the relevant documentations
- d) Onsite start-up and commissioning assistance (Proposed as an option at an hourly rate)
- e) Comprehensive list of manufacturer recommended Spare Parts

#### **4 Required Experience and Skills**

The candidates shall need to demonstrate that they have the capabilities to supply the required goods in full compliance with the applicable standards as well as with the ITER quality and safety requirements.

## 6 Candidature

Participation is open to all legal entities established in an ITER Member State, which is:

- European Union including Switzerland (EURATOM Members),
- Republic of India,
- Japan,
- People’s Republic of China,
- Republic of Korea,
- Russian Federation, or
- United States of America.

Entities can participate either individually or in a consortium. A legal entity cannot participate individually or as a consortium partner in more than one application or tender. A consortium may be a permanent, legally-established grouping or a grouping, which has been constituted informally for a specific tender procedure. All members of a consortium (i.e. the leader and all other members) are jointly and severally liable to the ITER Organization.

The consortium groupings shall be presented at the pre-qualification stage. The tenderer’s composition cannot be modified without the approval of the ITER Organization after the pre-qualification.

Legal entities belonging to the same legal grouping are allowed to participate separately if they are able to demonstrate independent technical and financial capacities. Candidates (individual or consortium) must comply with the selection criteria. The IO reserves the right to disregard duplicated reference projects and may exclude such legal entities from the pre-qualification procedure.
